Re: Background Materials for Airport Tours

As you know, the Study Resource Committee for the Master Plan/EIS for T.F. Green Airport will tour the airport on May 30, 2001. Committee members and alternates have been invited to attend one of the two tours scheduled for 6:30 a.m. -10:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. An itinerary for each of the tours is attached.

What We Will Be Seeing

The tour of T. F. Green Airport has been organized to allow all Study Resource Committee (SRC) members and alternates the opportunity to experience the airport and surrounding environment during almost-peak periods of the day. The areas to be visited on the tour include portions of the Sundlun Terminal, neighborhoods underneath the runway being used for departures on the day of the tour, the airfield (runways and taxiways), and the Airport's Traffic Control Tower (ATCT).

What to Bring

A series of useful materials are enclosed, including:

- an air photo of the airport;
- an exhibit with runway and taxiway names;
- an airline schedule for a typical day; and
- a copy of RIAC's voluntary land acquisition program map.

PLEASE BRING THESE MATERIALS TO HELP YOU WITH AIRPORT ORIENTATION. In addition, feel free to bring a camera; **HOWEVER**, no cameras can be allowed inside the Traffic Control Tower for security reasons.

Where to Meet

If you're on the morning tour, please meet **PROMPTLY** at 6:30 a.m. in the Hourly Parking Lot across from the terminal. We will return to the Hourly Lot by 10:15 a.m. For the afternoon tour, please meet **PROMPTLY** at 3:30 p.m. in the Hourly Lot. We will be back to the Hourly Lot by 7:15 p.m. **PARKING TICKETS WILL BE VALIDATED BY RIAC PERSONNEL.**
